

**LASU MANAGEMENT INAUGURATES COMMITTEE ON OPEN/DISTANCE LEARNING AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE**

Lagos State University on Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2017, took another giant step towards improving and developing the frontiers of education as the Vice Chancellor, Professor Lanre **Fagbohun**, on behalf of the University Management inaugurated the Committee to develop a proposal for the establishment of Open/Distance Learning and Research Institute of the University at the Senate Chamber, Main Campus, Ojo, Lagos.

While, inaugurating the Committee, which has a World renowned academic juggernaut, Professor Peter **Okebukola** as its Chairman. Professor, **Fagbohun** implored the Committee to do a thorough job that would make the founding fathers of the University proud.

He described the inauguration as historic in the annals of the University. He added that the Committee would be out to achieve two goals, in **"meeting the fundamental societal need and putting this University on the path of sustainable sustainability"**, saying, the Government cannot do it all alone. He stated that the event was the opening of another chapter as well as going into another face of the development at the institution.

The Vice Chancellor believed the Committee would do a great job, keeping to the terms of reference, with the calibre of the composition of its members. Thereafter, he inaugurated the 19-man Committee.

We must play out weaknesses of the earlier players and deliver quality"**.

The Registrar, Mr. Akinwunmi Oladapo **Lewis** on behalf of the University Management gave the vote of thanks. He thanked members of the Committee, despite their tight schedules for accepting the call to serve the University on this task. He wished the Committee a successful performance.

The Committee is expected to submit its report by March, this year and the timeline for the take off of the Institute is September 2017.

**DECISION EXTRACT OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE STUDENTS' DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE HELD ON WEDNESDAY, 14<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2016**

The Students' Disciplinary Committee, at its Special meeting held on Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2016 decided the following:

1. All students of the University are hereby warned, not to, for whatsoever reason, no matter how genuine, obstruct or resist the arrest of any person(s) /student(s) by the security personnel(s).
2. Any student, who obstructs or resist the arrest of fellow student(s) would be made to face stiffer sanctions/penalties from the Committee.
3. Any student(s) arrested by the security personnel would be given a right to call whoever he wishes to, on arrival at the security investigation Bureau (SIB) of the University.
