2.2 ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (CONUASS 06)

Candidates **MUST** possess Ph.D with Eight (8) years Post-doctoral/Fellowship qualification experience in teaching/research in a University. He/She must also possess some years of Post qualification teaching and research experience in a University with several scholarly publications, administrative experience and demonstrate ability to provide academic leadership.

2.3 SENIOR LECTURER (CONUASS 05)

Candidates **MUST** possess Ph.D [in **Nursing**] with Six (6) years Post-doctoral/Fellowship qualification experience in teaching/research in a University. He/She must also possess reasonable scholarly publications, administrative experience and demonstrate ability to provide academic leadership.
